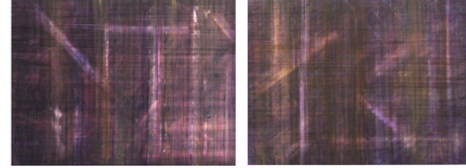


Image: untitled, C12-6H, acrylic on wood panels, 18" x 49" x2"

The richly reductive paintings of Ginny Fox will be on view at SOHO20 Chelsea Gallery October 30- November 24, 2012.

These subtly layered multi panel works on wood explore the merging of color, surface and light. Through a repetitive process of adding and removing paint and linear markings, Fox achieves a unique evocation of both natural and fabricated surfaces as well as a visual discourse between micro and macrocosm. The use of two or more panels within each painting provides a sense of connectedness and constant change. Additionally, Fox has created these pieces with the intent of relating them to the architecture of the space they are in; they may be installed horizontally or vertically. In this way, they not only maintain their own intimate space, but become an integral part of the larger environment as well.

Be it a close up view of a precious stone, threads of a textile, or a distant view of the night sky or landscape, these works are intended to elicit a sense of wonder and mystery, with a deeper appreciation for the world around us, in all its temporal beauty.

Ginny Fox has exhibited at Soho20 Chelsea Gallery for many years, as well as numerous venues throughout the U.S., including Pratt MWP Campus, Rockefeller State Park Preserve, and the Berkshire Museum. Her work has been reviewed in The New York Times, Abstract Art on Line, and Business Women's Calendar. Fox lives in the Bronx, and her studio is in Yonkers, New York.
